PROCIDENTIA REPAIR USING PORCINE GRAFTS AND UTEROSACRAL LIGAMENT SUSPENSION

Synopsis of Video

The total reconstruction of the pelvic floor in a patient with procidentia is one of the most difficult surgical repairs faced by the pelvic surgeon. This video demonstrates a comprehensive repair of the vagina addressing each compartment separately. Porcine grafts are used to reconstruct the anterior and posterior compartments. A uterosacral ligament suspension is performed to resuspend the vaginal apex. A sling is placed to address stress incontinence. The result is a functional vagina with excellent support in all compartments.
