Regarding the criterias of ICS, the proposed dates for holding this congress in Istanbul are in September. A reservation has already been made at the Istanbul Congress Center (ICC) for 25 - 30 September 2016. Istanbul has its most beautiful weather in September. The average temperature is 22^oC (68 F). The weather is usually sunny.

Proposed Venue

Istanbul offers three independent, integrable meeting clusters in the Airport area, the Congress Valley and the Golden Horn featuring state of the art facilities. Its hundreds of hotels in every category cater to every taste and budget and include top international brands, as well as distinguished local chains and independent properties. Combined with Istanbul's 60,000 guestrooms, the city's three meeting clusters, each capable of hosting events with 20,000 or more delegates, make the city ideal for congresses with 500 to 30,000 or more participants.
