Thus I think I am an academic urologist with broad experience in clinical as well as basic studies. I have experience of national and international member of committees and guideline panels on LUTD. I have been appointed as a Trustee of Japanese Neurogenic Bladder Society since 1988. I was once elected as a 4-year-term chairman of Prize Award Selection Committee of Japanese Neurogenic Bladder Society (2004-2008). |
