Registration for the Workshops is open to Course participants only. Cost of registration is \$50 including course material and coffee during breaks.

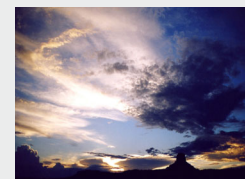
