
The Palais des Congrès de Paris in the 17th district is a place of business, convention and entertainment in the capital, located at Porte Maillot. The convention center is part of the same set a high-rise hotel, the Hyatt Regency, on the edge of the Bois de Boulogne

Built from 1970 by architect Guillaume Gillet, it was inaugurated in 1974. The imposing inclined facade dates of the rehabilitation in 1998. It is the work of the architect Christian de Portzamparc.

It consists of four lecture halls on four floors: **Grand Amphitheatre (3.700 seats)** - amphitheatres Bordeaux, Havana, Blue and smaller. The Palais des Congrès de Paris also has **many conference rooms on 2 levels and a shopping mall** on the ground floor.


LEVEL 2 AND LEVEL 3 FOR ICS 2019:

ICS ANNUAL DINNER : PARIS CITY HALL



Upon the Mayor of Paris' invitation, the ICS Annual Dinner could be served in the Salle des Fêtes of the Paris City Hall. The ballroom is the largest and most beautiful part of the City Hall. Copied to the Hall of Mirrors at Versailles, it is lined with windows that are reflected in mirrors. That could not compete with its long model, these designers have made wider and taller ceiling. 2 majestic 4 stars hotel complexes are located on-site: the Hyatt Regency (adjacent to the Palais des congrès, 33 floors and a beautiful view of Paris all around, especially at the Panoramic Bar: «La Vue» on the 33rd floor), and the Méridien Etoile (just across the street).

Together, the two hotels gather 2,000 deluxe rooms within less than 1 minute walking from the Palais des Congrès.
