


A unique opportunity to support the 6th edition of the book 'Incontinence', the product of the 6th International Consultation on Incontinence

How is the book produced?

Each new chapter in the book is the subject of an intensive, systematic update and review through the International Consultation on Incontinence (ICI). The ICI is one of the Consultations that are held under the auspices of the **International Consultation on Urological Diseases (ICUD)**. The 1st Consultation occurred in 1998 and since then the ICI has established itself as one of the foremost and widely quoted set of international guidelines on the management of urinary and faecal incontinence.

Close to 200 internationally recognised and research active experts work across 23 committees for up to two years to produce the indispensable book, "Incontinence". In 2016, the forthcoming consultation will result in the publication of the 6th edition in 2017. The ICI book vigorously examines and summarises the latest scientific evidence in the field of incontinence and remains a unique publication and reference source to all those who commit their professional lives to the traumatic effects of incontinence and pelvic floor dysfunction.

The scope of the consultation has gradually broadened so that it now includes 23 chapters, including faecal incontinence, pelvic organ prolapse, bladder pain syndrome and obstetric fistula. The chapters for the 6th edition are included at **Appendix A**.

The internationally renowned editors of the 6th edition of the ICI book are Paul Abrams, Linda Cardozo, Adrian Wagg and Alan Wein.
