Easily accessible

Strategically located at the crossroads of the three continents Europe, Asia and Africa, Dubai International Airport currently serves over 125 airlines flying to over 260 destinations across the world. DWTC - a centrally located venue

The DWTC complex is the largest purpose-built convention and exhibition centre in the Middle East, covering over 1.3 million square feet of event space. It is a fully integrated venue with restaurants, cafés, food outlets, ATMs, business centre, post office, and shops that hosts more than 500 events with over 3 million annual visitors from 160 global markets. worldwide. Dubai Metro links the Dubai International Airport to major business centres, hotels and shopping malls. Taxis and public buses are easily available throughout the city.

All year round sunshine

Dubai has a subtropical, arid climate with sunny blue skies most of the year. Rainfall is infrequent and irregular, mainly in winter. Temperatures range from minimum 27°C (81°F) to maximum 45°C (106°F) from June to September and minimum 14°C (57°F) to maximum 37°C (99°F) from October to May.

Safe city in a safe country

The UAE has been ranked the second-safest country in the world by the World Economic Forum (WEF) 2017. It has low-crime rates and is a politically-stable country.





Diverse social venues

When it comes to diversity of venues, Dubai can accommodate any type of event.
