# Female Stress Incontinence: Surgical Interventions

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
### Case #1

- 27yo woman with grade I SUI persisting one year after the birth of a son.
- Feels tissue when she wipes, not bothersome
- Has been doing PFMT religiously
- Exam: 60 degrees mobility, drops of SUI, cystocele +1cm, cervix -1cm

How does your thinking change if patient is 47?

### Case #2

- 58yo female who leaks with cough, most physical activity.
- Voids every hour during the day and every 2 hours at night.
- Frequent urgency, urge incontinence daily
- Oxybutynin ER 10mg didn't affect much
- Exam 30 degrees BN mobility, good support, no SUI



### Case #3

 A 36yo female presents with the complaint that her UI is worse since undergoing a mid-urethral sling 5 months ago

How does your thinking change if the procedure was a TOT sling and repair stage 3 cystocele?

## Case #4

- A 55yo woman presents after her friend had complete resolution of her UI after an outpatient operation. "I want the same thing".
- Hourly voiding, N x 4
- Leaks with sneezing, sometimes coughing
- Good support, 30 degrees BN mobility
