1. PURPOSE:

The Standardisation Steering Committee establishes terminology and methodology in the International Continence Society's areas of activity, to underpin professional standards of clinical management and research

2. FUNCTIONS:

- Working to develop and support a programme of development of professional Standardisation documents relating to terminology, diagnostics, clinical management and research in the areas of activity of the ICS
- Undertaking timely revision of Standardisation documents to ensure they retain contemporaneous relevance, assimilating feedback from all stakeholders
- Promoting adherence to Standardisation document recommendations in professional practice of all clinicians and allied professionals working in ICS areas of activity
- Providing regular information on SSC activity to the ICS membership
- Supporting infrastructure for reciprocal and responsive dialogue between the SSC and the ICS membership
- Developing and maintaining a high-quality SSC microsite on the ICSOffice.org website
- Providing advice to the ICS Trustees in relation to policy issues that relate to the SSC activities
- Developing effective working relationships with other ICS Committees and allied organisations outside the ICS

Recent Highlights in 2019

• ICS Glossary: An online collation of 1124 terms/descriptors from all ICS documents back to 2000. This works well on mobile handsets. Features include: (i) access to all recent and past references for each term; (ii) instant copying of each reference; (iii) instant download of all reference documents; (iv) instant contribution to more extensive feedback via ICS Terminology Discussion (below); (v) instant short feedback to ICS Office. This provides the ultimate facility for terminology accessibility, exclusive to ICS.

• **Rebranding of ICS Wiki as ICS Terminology Discussion:** With the online access provided by the Glossary, ICS terminology feedback has been directed through the Glossary portal as ICS Terminology Discussion. This is under the leadership of Sajjad Rahnama'l and Sarah Haag.

• Terminology for Male LUT/PF Dysfunction (D'Ancona, Haylen et al): This is the first ever male-only core terminology document for LUT/PF Dysfunction. It comprises 390 terms, 211 (54%) NEW and 71 (18%) changed. It is the basis for other Male-only ICS Terminology documents. It provides a complement to the Terminology for Female Pelvic Floor Dysfunction (Haylen et al. 2010)

• Terminology for Nocturia and Nocturnal Lower Urinary Tract Function (Hashim et al): This is an update of the Nocturia document of 2002 (Van Kerrebroeck et al).

Collaborations:

The Chair was in weekly contact with Joe Lee, Chairman Standardization and Terminology IUGA till the end of 2019. The new Chair, Renaud de Tayrac will attend the SSC Meeting in Tokyo. The only current projects (both also with AUGS) are the (i) Pelvic Floor Fistula and (ii) Female Obstetric Trauma documents. All three Chairs were keen to start an ICS-IUGA update of the Terminology for Female Pelvic Floor Dysfunction under a simplified (6 members chosen by each Society) arrangement. An SOP was submitted in January 2019. This arrangement was not approved by the respective Boards.

Standardisation Steering Committee

Since the Annual Meeting in Gothenburg, the Standardisation Steering Committee have been extremely busy, finalising and publishing two new documents and launching the new ICS glossary!

ICS GLOSSARY: The ICS Glossary offers <u>instant online access</u> to all ICS terminology published over the last 18 years – over **1120 terms.** It also allows <u>instant online access</u> to and the <u>ability to instantly</u> <u>download</u> all the original documents from which those terms come. <u>https://www.ics.org/glossary</u>

The Male-terminology document, referred to below, will be the first and most recent reference with other documents referenced in reverse chronological order (most recent to earliest). ICS is uniquely placed to produce the Glossary, having updated all male and female lower urinary tract and pelvic floor terminology over the last 12 years. ICS is now able to offer this comprehensive terminology service in an exciting electronic presentation. It takes access to terminology to a totally different and unprecedented level. The new glossary is mobile friendly and designed to work perfectly on small devices, on the move: https://www.ics.org/glossary

NEW 2019 REPORTS: The two reports are:

- ICS Report on the terminology for Adult Male Lower Urinary Tract (LUT) and Pelvic Floor (PF) Symptoms and Dysfunction. This is the first core male LUT/PF terminology for males with 54% new definitions/descriptors and 18% changed. It provides the basis for the four male documents in the list below. It complements the equivalent 2010 document for female lower urinary tract dysfunction (Haylen et al).
- The ICS Report on the terminology for Nocturia and Nocturnal Lower Urinary Tract Function. This is an update of the 2002 document on the Terminology for Nocturia (Van Kerrebroeck et al).
