
53rd ANNUAL MEETING OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONTINENCE SOCIETY ICS 2023 - TORONTO, CANADA



We are pleased to propose Toronto as the host city for the ICS 2023 Annual Meeting. Annual ICS meetings have been held since 1971 and the 11th Annual ICS Meeting was held in Lund in 1981. It is our pleasure, after many years, to welcome you back to Canada and to the city of Toronto. Canada has a long scientific tradition in incontinence research and many prominent scientists have been engaged in the International Continence Society and its important work.
