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All articles published open access will be immediately and permanently free for everyone to read, download, copy and distribute. This ensures that scientific content is available to anyone and is not restricted by a subscription paywall, therefore proliferating the sharing of science worldwide.

2. Open Access Fee (Article Publishing Charge – APC)

As an open access journal with no subscription charges, a fee is payable by the author or research funder to cover the costs associated with publication. This ensures your article will be immediately and permanently free to access by everyone, worldwide.

As a benefit to ICS members the Article Publishing Charge will be waived for the first two years (2022 & 2023). From 2024 onwards the fee for ICS members will be at a reduced price of 50% of the standard fee.

The general Open Access Fee will be USD 1,800 in 2022. The journal can consider a limited number of waivers of the fee on a case-by-case basis

As a member benefit, all valid ICS members will receive a 50% discount on Article Publishing Charges.

3. How many issues per year?

We are working on the basis of 4 issues in the first year. This could then rise to 6 issues per year in subsequent years.

4. When will the new journal be listed on PubMed?

A journal can be added to PubMed following the publication of 25 articles. That will be the first goal of the journals, which we plan to reach by mid-2022.

5. How will the new journals receive an Impact Factor

We will ensure the journals contain top quality content and meet the general conditions of the council that decide upon impact factors. The goal is to be awarded an impact factor within 2-3 years.

6. Funding body agreements
