world cup in Brazil, but in the south of
Brazil we will not have games in july.

Need for course: Why is important that the ICS runs a course for this audience? What do you feel the benefit to you will be? What can ICS provide that local providers will be unable to deliver?

The South Brazilian Urological Congress is a traditional and important urological meeting. The meeting this year will be together with the Italian-Brazilian urological congress. This will be an important scientific event, and we would be proud if ICS could be present and supporting us. We believe that we will have the same success in this event than we had in 2011, when we had an educational course in Porto Alegre, with the South Brazilian Urological society. Were present around 200 delegates only in the ICS EC and there was a great scientific level of presentations. At that time, we had a participation of nurses, physiotherapists, urologists and gynaecologist promoting the multidisciplinary of treatment, one of the main issue Brazil needs to develop.

This year is especially important because we will have the main ICS congress in Brazil (first time in Latin America), and this Educational Course is supposed to spread the news about the congress and make the participants excited to attend ICS congress in Rio. We expect that a lot of delegates of our meeting will make contact and will participate of the ICS meeting in Rio de Janeiro.

As we know, this will be the only Educational course in Brazil in 2014, and this is important to keep the ICS in mind, because we were having at least two Educational Courses in Brazil each year in the last three years. And it's really important to keep this tradition as all the meetings were a success. The own ICS recognized the importance of having educational courses in Brazil, during this year, because ICS is incentivising this kind of meeting in its website.

We believe that with the participation of ICS in our meeting, we could improve first of all the level of the meeting, the number of ICS associates and increase the participation of our colleagues in the ICS as members. By the other hand, the ICS participation in our meeting will increase the number of delegates in our audience, and we will increase the number of international speakers. We are confident that this will improve the scientific level and participation of a large number of colleagues.

The ICS international speakers are suppose to disseminate the ICS mission and standards, especially about standardization, terminology and multidisciplinary work. Those are important points to be discussed in Brazil. We are expecting a large number of physiotherapist and we are supposed to strength the collaboration between the specialties. This is one of the reasons to include a geriatrician and a physiotherapist together with an urologist as ICS international speakers in our meeting. We hope that ICS accept this application, as an add-on Educational Course and we are sure that we will have a great meeting together with such respectable organization that we are proud to be part.

Gramado



Gramado is a small city (~30.000 habitants) 118 km (74 miles) away from Porto Alegre, the capital of the state of Rio Grande do Sul, in the south of Brazil, close to Uruguai and Argentina. Most of the population of Gramado is of German or Italian descent and its architecture and gastronomy reflects that. Gramado hosts the majorSouth American film festival and is also known for its natural landscapes and the beautiful hydrangeas blossoming in late spring.

The average temperature for the conference period can vary greatly (3-19°C / 37-66°F), so participants are recommended to bring clothes for cold weather. Gramado is in the same time zone as Brasília, Porto Alegre, Rio de Janeiro, and São Paulo: 3 hours behind GMT. To get to Gramado from abroad, you should first take a flight to Porto Alegre (Salgado Filho Int'l Airport) and then take a terrestrial transportation.

Salgado Filho Int'l Airport is the largest, busiest airport located in Porto Alegre, Rio Grande do Sul, Southern Brazil. Salgado Filho Airport is well served by domestic flights, specially from Brazil's two most important gateway ports: Rio de Janeiro (Antônio Carlos Jobim Int'l Airport) and São Paulo/Guarulhos (Gov. André Franco Montoro Int'l Airport). Besides, there are also international flights with direct connections to Salgado Filho departing from cities of the Southern Cone (e.g., Buenos Aires and Montevideo).

Departing from Porto Alegre, the possible transportation means towards Gramado are transfer service, taxi or bus. Additional information on these possibilities are presented below as well as guiding for those in need of visa to participate in the event.

From Salgado Filho Int'l Airport to Gramado (and return) From Porto Alegre to Gramado, the maximum waiting time in the airport will be 45 minutes. The fare per person is R\$ 110,00 (~U\$ 63.00).

From Salgado Filho Int'l Airport to Gramado (one way) From Porto Alegre to Gramado, the maximum waiting time in the airport will be 45 minutes. The fare per person is R\$ 55,00 (~U\$ 32.00).

From Gramado to Salgado Filho Int'l Airport (one way) The fare per person is R\$ 55,00 (~U\$ 32.00).

By Bus

In order to take a bus to Gramado you have two main options: depart straight from the airport or depart from Porto Alegre's main bus station. The buses that stop by the airport leave from the bus station as well, but just on a given set of departure times, as you will see on the time tables below.

The fare to go from the airport to Gramado by bus is of R\$ 26,90 (~U\$ 15,25 including insurance) and the ticket should be bought at the Veppo company stand number 18B, which is near to the arrival zone at the first floor
