

Peter L. Rosenblatt, M.D.

Professor of Obstetrics, Gynecology & Reproductive Biology

Dr. Rosenblatt is a legend in the current Urogynaecological scenario. A committed teacher and an excellent surgeon, he is currently a Professor in OB/GYN in the Harvard system. His awards and accolades are too many to fit in here, but examples are:

- Participated in many studies on women's incontinence and post-market study of the "uphold" device for POP and many other mesh products.

Holly Elizabeth Richter, M.D.

Dr. Holly Richter is the appointed Professor, the endowed chair of OB/GYN, Urology, Urogynecology pelvic reconstructive surgery., University of Alabama Hospital and Clinics, Director Genito-rectal Disorders Clinic, Center for Research in Women's Health and Ambulatory Clinical Director. - She has authored many prize-winning anatomy papers and videos. She has written chapters in two of the highly peer-reviewed books in Urogynecology
- She is devoted to education and received the Outstanding Faculty Teaching Award in 2002 and the ACOG Mentor of the Year award in 2013.
- Dr. Corton is dedicated to promoting excellence in gynecologic surgery through acquiring knowledge and advancing research and education.

The Cadaver Workshop

13th October, 2023

"It is not how fast you get there; it is how safely you get there!"

Knowing this is the hall mark of both, a good surgeon and a good driver. Operating without a thorough knowledge of anatomy is like driving without directions. Not knowing where to go, what dangers and pitfalls are ahead, and how to avoid them can be a menace. It is crucial to identify the warning signs and red flags.

This is truer for pelvic surgeons since they are operating in a cramped space, full of important organs with complex relationships. Venous plexuses, bowel, bladder, arteries and our arch enemy "the Ureter," crop up unexpectedly.



"Keep your friends close and your enemies closer" is a valuable dictum.

Keeping the Ureter close (in vision) but away from sutures or scissors is an art that you acquire if you know the pelvic anatomy well.

We are offering a unique opportunity on the 13 th of October 2023, to observe the pelvic and perineal anatomy by a master anatomist/Urogyn on cadavers. Following this, world-renowned faculty will guide you through many of the Prolapse and Incontinence procedures on the cadavers. This would be of immense help when you operate on live patients in your practice.

We may have been good at anatomy in our college days, but let's face it- we all feel the need to revisit the pelvic anatomy after a few years of practice. This is a golden opportunity that should not be missed.

We will be accommodating 60 delegates in the lab to be able to give each one an extensive hands-on experience.




